

Diné Development Corporation's Privacy Policy

Diné Development Corporation ("DDC") respects your right to privacy and is committed to protecting your personal data when you register to access our content, submit a request to receive information from DDC, or visit and interact with DDC on our website, ddc-dine.com (the "Service"). We publish this Privacy Policy to explain our commitment to privacy and help you understand the choices available to you about how your information is collected and used.

This Privacy Policy is used to inform website visitors regarding our policies with the collection, use, and disclosure of personal information when using our Service. It applies to information DDC collects on the Service, in email, text, and other electronic messages between you and the Service, through mobile desktop applications you download from the Service, and when you interact with DDC advertising and applications on third-party websites and services.

If you choose to use our Service, then you consent to the collection and use of your information in relation with this Privacy Policy. Information Collection and Use

For a better experience while using our Service, we may require you to provide us with certain personally identifiable information, including but not limited to your name, phone number, and postal address. The information that we collect will be used to contact or identify you. We may also collect: (i) information that is about you but individually does not identify you; (ii) performance and log data, such as information about your internet connection, the equipment you use to access our Service, and usage details; and, (iii) any other information you voluntarily provide to us.



We collect this information:

- Directly from you when you provide it to us.
- Automatically as you navigate through the Service. Information collected automatically may include usage details, Internet Protocol ("IP") addresses, and information collected through cookies and other tracking technologies.
- From third parties (e.g., our business partners).

Technologies we use for automatic data collection may include Log Data and Cookies:

- Log Data: We want to inform you that whenever you visit our Service, we collect information that your browser sends to us called Log Data. This Log Data may include information such as your computer's IP address, browser version, pages of our Service that you visit, the time and date of your visit, the time spent on those pages, and other statistics.
- Cookies: Cookies are files with small amounts of data that are commonly used as an anonymous unique identifier. - Diagnose any problems with our server and administer the Service.
- We also may use this information in aggregate to better understand our Service's readership.
- Respond to your inquiries. Without your personal information, we would be unable to respond to any questions, concerns, feedback, disputes or issues.
- Monitor, investigate, prevent, and mitigate any alleged or actual prohibited, illicit or illegal activities in connection with services DDC provides.



- Combat spam, malware, malicious activities or security risks and to improve and enforce DDC security measures.
- Research and development to help us improve our Service, build new services, and customize features for the Service.

Service Providers

We may employ third-party companies and individuals due to the following reasons:

- To facilitate our Service;
- To provide the Service on our behalf;
- To perform Service-related services; or
- To assist us in analyzing how our Service is used.

We want to inform our Service users that these third parties have access to your personal information that may be collected pursuant to this Privacy Policy in order to perform tasks assigned to them on our behalf. However, they are obligated not to disclose or use the information for any other purpose.

The only entities outside DDC that may have access to your personal information are: 1) third parties that help DDC operate the Service; 2) law enforcement or other government entities if reasonably required; and 3) a third party in the case of the reorganization, sale, merger, joint venture, assignment, transfer or other disposition of all or any portion of our business, asset or stocks, including in the event of corporate restructuring.

Security

We value your trust in providing us with your personal information, thus we strive to use commercially acceptable means of protecting it. To prevent unauthorized access, maintain data accuracy, and ensure the correct use of information, we have
